### **Availability of a trial version of the application BR IFIC (Space services) online**

After the successful online distribution of the BRIFIC (Space services) in ISO format and considering the need for the BR IFIC application to renew its technology, the Bureau will provide to Administrations and users an online interface to browse the BR IFIC (Space services) content and to download the relevant information (publications and databases).

This online application “BR IFIC (Space services) online” is now available for beta testing by administrations and all other users (subscribers) at the following webpage:

### **Trial Period**

The trial of the BR IFIC online will be opened until 1<sup>st</sup> of May 2023.

During the trial period, this online application will be available solely for testing purpose and should not be considered as the official release of the BR IFIC.

Based on the results of the trial and feedback gathered from administrations and users, the Bureau will put in place a production version of the application. This will be announced in a circular letter.
